	The bill requires uncertified potato seed stock be tested and approved prior to planting. It increases state workload and potentially state revenue on an ongoing basis.		
Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation is required.

Summary of Legislation

The bill amends the Colorado Potato Seed Act to require potato growers to submit any uncertified potato seed stock to the certifying authority, the Department of Agriculture (CDA), for testing prior to planting. The CDA must then approve the uncertified potato seed stock if it meets standards established by the Commissioner of Agriculture.

State Revenue

Violations of the Colorado Seed Potato Act are subject to fines collected by the CDA when civil penalties are issued. This may increase revenue to the department, but any revenue increase is expected to be minimal. This revenue is subject to TABOR.

State Expenditures

The bill minimally increases workload in the CDA, in conjunction with Colorado State University, to test uncertified potato seeds. Workload may also increase to address any violations of the act. This increase is absorbable within existing appropriations.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
