	The bill would have allowed a person to remove, discontinue, or replace telecommunications equipment identified as a threat to national security without obtaining additional permits from local governments. It may have decreased local revenue and expenditures on an ongoing basis.		
Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation was required.		
Fiscal Note Status:	The final fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. This bill was postponed indefinitely by Senate Business, Labor, and Technology Committee on February 22, 2024; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.		

Summary of Legislation

The Federal Communications Commission publishes a list of telecommunications equipment and services that pose a national security threat and should be removed, discontinued, or replaced. The bill establishes that a person who removes, discontinues, or replaces any equipment in the covered list is not required to receive additional permits from a local government if the local government receives notification and replacement equipment is functionally similar to the removed equipment.

Local Government

The bill may minimally impact local governments in two ways. First, it may reduce local government permit revenue and workload for affected projects. Second, local governments may have additional workload to update information and permit-related materials to reflect the change under the bill.
