It may decrease state expenditures beginning in FY 2024-25. **Appropriation** No appropriation is required. **Summary: Fiscal Note** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Joint Status: Technology Committee.

### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill allows a procurement official to select the most appropriate source selection method, given time requirements, financial considerations, and market conditions, even when a source selection method is specified in statute.

### **State Expenditures**

The bill may decrease state expenditures in any state agency beginning in FY 2024-25 if their procurement processes are adjusted to select sources that are more cost effective. Any cost savings will vary on a per-procurement basis and cannot be estimated.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
