A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE MODERNIZATION OF THE STATE PLANE COORDINATE**
102 **SYSTEM.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <http://leg.colorado.gov>.)

Current law allows the use of the Colorado coordinate system of 1927 and the Colorado coordinate system of 1983 established by the national geodetic survey to state the geographic positions or locations of points on the surface of the earth within the state. The bill allows the use of the most recent or a prior version of the state plane coordinate system for the same purpose.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 38-52-106.5 as
3 follows:

4 **38-52-106.5. State plane coordinate system updates.**

5 (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION IN THIS ARTICLE 52 TO THE
6 CONTRARY, EXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 38-52-104, A PERSON MAY
7 USE THE MOST RECENT OR A PRIOR VERSION OF THE STATE PLANE
8 COORDINATE SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY THE NATIONAL GEODETIC SURVEY
9 OR ITS SUCCESSOR ORGANIZATION TO STATE THE GEOGRAPHIC POSITIONS
10 OR LOCATIONS OF POINTS ON THE SURFACE OF THE EARTH WITHIN THE
11 STATE.

12 (2) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PROHIBITS A PERSON FROM USING
13 THE COLORADO COORDINATE SYSTEM OF 1927 OR THE COLORADO
14 COORDINATE SYSTEM OF 1983, AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION
15 38-52-101 (1), TO STATE THE GEOGRAPHIC POSITIONS OR LOCATIONS OF
16 POINTS ON THE SURFACE OF THE EARTH WITHIN THE STATE.

17 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
18 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
19 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
20 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
21 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
22 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
23 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
24 November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
25 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
