A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN NONPROFIT HOSPITALS

102 TO ENTER INTO COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER

103 HEALTH FACILITIES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. In 2023, the general assembly authorized certain public hospitals to enter into collaborative agreements with other hospitals or hospital affiliates to engage in activities to increase access to health care. The bill authorizes private, nonprofit hospitals with fewer than 50 beds to also enter into collaborative agreements.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-1-1001, amend 3 (2)(e)(II) and (2)(e)(III); and **add** (2)(e)(IV) as follows: 4 25.5-1-1001. Hospital collaborative agreements - review of proposed collaborative agreements - immunity - legislative 5 6 declaration - definitions - rules. (2) As used in this section, unless the 7 context otherwise requires: 8 (e) "Hospital" means a facility with fewer than fifty beds that is: 9 (II) A hospital established, maintained, or operated directly or 10 indirectly by a health service district; or 11 (III) A hospital affiliate; OR 12 (IV) A PRIVATE, NONPROFIT HOSPITAL. 13 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 25-3-304.5 14 as follows: 15 25-3-304.5. Hospital collaborative agreements - additional 16 powers. In addition to the powers specified in section 25-3-304, the board 17 of trustees of a county public hospital may enter into a collaborative 18 agreement with another county public hospital; A health service district; 19 or A hospital affiliate; OR A PRIVATE, NONPROFIT HOSPITAL in accordance 20 with section 25.5-1-1001. 21 SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 32-1-1003, amend (1)(c.5) as follows: 22 23 **32-1-1003.** Health service districts - additional powers. (1) In 24 addition to the powers specified in section 32-1-1001, the board of any 25 health service district has any or all of the following powers for and on 26 behalf of such district:

1 (c.5) To enter into a collaborative agreement with another health 2 service district; A county public hospital; or A hospital affiliate; OR A 3 PRIVATE, NONPROFIT HOSPITAL in accordance with section 25.5-1-1001; 4 SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 5 6 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 7 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 8 9 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 10 11 November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 12 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
