90 Department of Personnel, Division of Capital Assets, Fleet Management Program and Motor Pool Services, Vehicle Replacement Lease/Purchase -- Pursuant to Section 24-82-801 (1)(b) and (1)(c), C.R.S., the Department of Personnel is authorized to enter into a financed purchase of an asset or certificate of participation agreement for the approved vehicle replacements and additions for the 2024-25 state fiscal year. The financed purchase of an asset or certificate of participation agreement is for a period of up to ten years and shall not exceed the amount of \$47,000,000. **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state institutions.
