A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING REPORTING STATISTICS ON RESTITUTION PAYMENTS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Starting with the judicial department's 2026 "SMART Act" hearing, the bill requires the state court administrator to report statistics concerning restitution payments received and owed during the previous 5 state fiscal years.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
institutions.
