A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING AUTHORIZING PROBATION EMPLOYEES TO DISCLOSE**
102 **INFORMATION TO IMMIGRATION AUTHORITIES FOR CERTAIN**
103 **INDIVIDUALS.**

Bill Summary

The bill allows a probation officer or employee to provide personal information about an individual to federal immigration authorities if the individual is on probation for certain violent felony offenses.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-76.6-103, **amend**
3 (1) as follows:

4 **24-76.6-103. Limitations on providing personal information**
5 **by probation offices.** (1) A probation officer or probation department
6 employee shall not provide personal information about an individual to
7 federal immigration authorities UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL IS ON PROBATION
8 FOR A SENTENCE FOR FIRST DEGREE MURDER, SECOND DEGREE MURDER,
9 FIRST DEGREE ASSAULT, FIRST DEGREE KIDNAPPING, FIRST OR SECOND
10 DEGREE SEXUAL ASSAULT, FIRST DEGREE ARSON, FIRST DEGREE
11 BURGLARY, OR AGGRAVATED ROBBERY.

12 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
15 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
16 institutions.
