## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING AN EXTENSION OF SPENDING AUTHORITY FOR THE 102 COLORADO STATE FOREST SERVICE SEEDLING TREE NURSERY.

## **Bill Summary**

Joint Budget Committee. For money appropriated to the Colorado state university system for use by the Colorado state forest service to renovate and expand the seedling tree nursery, the bill extends the spending authority through the 2026-27 state fiscal year.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-31-319, amend
3	(6) and (8) as follows:
4	23-31-319. Forest service seedling tree nursery - necessary
5	upgrades and improvements - definition - funding - reports - repeal.
6	(6) <b>Appropriation.</b> For the 2022-23 and 2023-24 state fiscal years, the
7	general assembly shall appropriate money to the Colorado state university
8	system for allocation to and expenditure by the Colorado state forest
9	service for the purposes specified in this section. Any money appropriated
10	by the general assembly pursuant to this subsection (6) that is not
11	expended before the end of the fiscal year for which it is appropriated
12	remains available for expenditure for the same purposes until the close of
13	the <del>2024-25</del> 2026-27 state fiscal year.
14	(8) <b>Repeal.</b> This section is repealed, effective <del>January 1, 2026</del>
15	June 30, 2027.
16	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
17	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
19	the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
20	institutions.
