A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 101CONCERNING ADDING MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT TO THE LIST OF102OFFENSES THAT APPLY TO THE OFFENSE OF POSSESSION OF
- 103 WEAPONS BY PREVIOUS OFFENDERS.

Bill Summary

Under current law, it is illegal for a person to possess a firearm if the person was convicted of or adjudicated for certain felonies. The bill adds motor vehicle theft in the first, second, and third degree to the list of violations that prohibit a person from possessing a firearm.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-12-108, add
3	(7)(n.4), (7)(n.5), and (7)(n.6) as follows:
4	18-12-108. Possession of weapons by previous offenders. (7) In
5	addition to a conviction for felony crime as defined in section 24-4.1-302
6	(1), a felony conviction or adjudication for one of the following felonies
7	prohibits a person from possessing, using, or carrying upon the person a
8	firearm as defined in section 18-1-901 (3)(h) or any other weapon that is
9	subject to this article 12 pursuant to subsection (1) or (3) of this section:
10	(n.4) Motor vehicle theft in the first degree in violation
11	OF SECTION 18-4-409;
12	(n.5) Motor vehicle theft in the second degree in violation
13	OF SECTION 18-4-409;
14	(n.6) Motor vehicle theft in the third degree in violation
15	OF SECTION 18-4-409;
16	SECTION 2. Applicability. This act applies to offenses
17	committed on or after the effective date of this act.
18	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
19	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
20	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
21	the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
22	institutions.
