A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A CHILD RESTRAINT SYSTEM.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill requires an insurer that issues or renews an automobile insurance policy to include coverage for the replacement of a child restraint system that sustains damage during a vehicle accident to which the coverage is applicable.

8	DAMAGE DURING A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT TO WHICH THE COVERAGE
9	IN THE POLICY IS APPLICABLE.
