A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING MEASURES TO PROTECT INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR
102 PREVENTIVE HEALTH-CARE SERVICES.

Bill Summary

Current law mandates mandatory insurance coverage of certain preventive health-care services (preventive services) in accordance with the recommendations of the United States preventive services task force, recommendations established by the advisory committee on immunization practices, or preventive care or screening as provided in the comprehensive guidelines supported by the health resources and services

administration in the United States department of health and human services (authorities).

The bill requires that, in the event that any of these authorities is repealed, modified, or otherwise no longer in effect, the commissioner of insurance may adopt rules to require compliance with the recommendations and comprehensive guidelines regarding the coverage of those preventive services as the recommendations and guidelines existed in January 2025.

6 **definitions.** (b) The coverage required by this subsection (18) must
7 include coverage for the ~~following~~ preventive health-care services LISTED
8 IN SUBSECTIONS (18)(b)(I) TO (18)(b)(XI) OF THIS SECTION in accordance
9 with the A or B recommendations of the task force, recommendations
10 established by the ACIP, or preventive care and screening as provided for
11 in the comprehensive guidelines. ~~as applicable~~ IF THE TASK FORCE, THE
12 ACIP, OR THE COMPREHENSIVE GUIDELINES ARE REPEALED, MODIFIED, OR
13 OTHERWISE NO LONGER IN EFFECT, THE COMMISSIONER MAY ADOPT RULES
14 TO REQUIRE COMPLIANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES OR RECOMMENDATIONS
15 THAT WERE IN EFFECT IN JANUARY 2025, OR THAT COMPLY WITH THE
16 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE NURSE-PHYSICIAN ADVISORY TASK FORCE FOR
17 COLORADO HEALTH CARE CREATED IN SECTION 12-30-105, THAT APPLY TO
18 COVERAGE OF THE FOLLOWING PREVENTIVE HEALTH-CARE SERVICES:

5 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,
6 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
7 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
8 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
9 institutions.
