1 WHEREAS, The Korean War, often called the "Forgotten War",
2 took place from 1950 through 1953, during which brave American
3 soldiers and allies fought to defend freedom and democracy under harsh
4 conditions; and

5 WHEREAS, Korean War veterans sacrificed greatly, returning
6 home to little recognition, yet their courage and commitment remain a
7 testament to their patriotism; and

8 WHEREAS, The sacrifices of these veterans are now more fully
9 appreciated, and their legacy has become an essential part of our nation's
