- (3) That the President of the Senate and the Chair of the House Services Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, are hereby separately authorized to retain and hire replacements for employees referred to in subsection (1) of this resolution for such period of time in the interim between the First Regular Session of the Seventy-fifth General Assembly and the Second Regular Session of the Seventy-fifth General Assembly as they deem necessary for their respective houses.
- (4) That the President of the Senate and the Chair of the House Services Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, are hereby separately authorized to hire such session-only employees for the next regular session as they deem necessary for their respective houses and who may start their employment on the date authorized.
