## **Summary of Legislation**

---

The bill replaces existing gendered language with gender-neutral language in Title 35 (Agriculture) of the Colorado Revised Statutes. It also updates archaic language in the title.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

---

Making nonsubstantive changes to Title 35 does not affect the revenue or expenditures for any state or local government. The Revisor of Statutes can make the updates within the normal course of business. As such, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## **Effective Date**

---

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
