Fiscal Assessment of L.001 to HB25-1158

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed amendment L.001 to HB25-1158. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment only. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

Summary of Proposed Amendment L.001

Amendment L.001 removes the requirement that the Department of Education collect and compile reports submitted by public schools to vendors of digital collections. The amendment also removes the requirement for public libraries to disclose details of contracts and agreements.

Fiscal Impact of Amendment L.001

Amendment L.001 removes the state expenditure of \$43,700 identified in the fiscal note dated February 3, 2025, by no longer requiring the Department of Education to develop a new reporting database to receive complaints regarding contracts with digital collections vendors.

Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment L.001

As amended, no appropriation is required, as shown in Table 1. Workload for school districts will increase to update policies, modify contracts with digital education providers, and distribute information to parents to comply with the bill. The amount of time required for this work will vary between school districts.
