The bill is dependent on gifts, grants, and donations for implementation on an accelerated timeline. For accelerated implementation, the bill requires expenditures of \$20,000 in FY 2026-27 if sufficient gifts, grants, and donations are received in FY 2025-26. If the necessary revenue from these sources is not realized, the implementation will occur by July 1, 2028, on the Department's normal standards review timeline.
