Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001

Staff amendment **J.001** (attached) reduces a General Fund appropriation by a total of \$20,246 to the Department of Labor and Employment for FY 2025-26. The appropriation reflects a reduction of 0.2 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

1. The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2025-26. This bill requires a General Fund reduction of \$20,246 for FY 2025-26, increasing the General Fund available for other FY 2025-26 appropriations by this amount.
