## **Fiscal Impacts**

Appropriation Already Added to Bill, No Amendment in Packet

#### **Fiscal Note Status**

The most recent Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note (attached) reflects the fiscal impact of the bill as of 02/03/25.

### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriations clause that makes the following changes for FY 2024-25:

- An increase of \$64,076,611 cash funds from the State Education Fund for the State Share of
  Districts' Total Program funding. Total program funding (including state and local shares)
  increases by \$38.5 million; because local revenues are \$25.6 million lower than anticipated in
  the original appropriation the state share is increased by \$64.1 million.
- An adjustment to the FY 2024-25 Long Bill footnote detailing total funding for the Teacher Recruitment Education and Preparation (TREP) Program for FY 2024-25 to align with the actual usage of program "slots" in the current year. The original appropriation assumed 250 slots for the program in FY 2024-25 but school districts are actually using or retaining a total of 210 slots.
