Summary Information

Overview. The bill clarifies the conditions under which special districts may cancel uncontested elections for district director.

Types of impacts. The bill is projected to affect the following areas on an ongoing basis:

Summary of Legislation

The bill allows special districts to cancel uncontested elections for district director when that is the only question on the ballot.

Local Government

Expenditures will decrease for special districts to the extent they operate fewer elections. Due to the variability in the cost and frequency of the impacted elections, this impact cannot be estimated.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
