# **Department Overview**

The Department of Higher Education is responsible for higher education and vocational training programs in the state. The Colorado Commission on Higher Education (CCHE) serves as the central policy and coordinating board for the Department. The majority of state funding for higher education institutions is distributed through the College Opportunity Fund Program, which includes two components: stipends to resident students for undergraduate education and fee-for-service contracts with institutions for graduate, professional, rural, and other specialized training.

## **Request/Recommendation Descriptions**

**COF Stipend and Fee for Service Contract Alignment:** The request, *previously approved by the Committee in June 2013*, adjusts several line items with a net \$0 impact to match data about the student population eligible for stipends in FY 2012-13. The adjustments are reflected in the table below. The adjustment to student stipend amounts are based on the difference between the students forecasted to be eligible for stipends, based on February 2013 data, and final figures. The variance between projected and actual students eligible for stipends was (0.1) percent. The largest variance for any governing board was (5.3) percent (Adams State). Fee-for-service contract adjustments compensate for the stipend adjustments so that total funding for each institution does not change.
