- 4 otherwise covered pursuant to section 18-3-407.5 or any other victim
- 5 compensation program.".
- 6 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 4 and substitute "develop a policy for
- 7 administering the program. The policy must include a requirement to
- 8 establish a cap for the amount payable per victim based on actual and
- 9 reasonable costs and available funds, but the minimum cap must not be

- 14 "(a.5) A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MUST REQUEST
- 15 REIMBURSEMENT TO HAVE COSTS COVERED THROUGH THE PROGRAM. THE
- 16 DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SHALL DEVELOP A POLICY, INCLUDING A
- 17 REQUIREMENT TO ESTABLISH A CAP, FOR THE AMOUNT PAYABLE TO A LAW
- 18 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY BASED ON ACTUAL AND REASONABLE COSTS AND
- 19 AVAILABLE FUNDS. THE PROGRAM MUST COVER COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH
- 20 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-33.5-113.5.".
- 21 Page 6, strike lines 14 through 21.
- Page 7, line 5, strike "DENIED," and substitute "DENIED AND REASONS FOR
- DENIAL,".
- Page 7, line 11, after "REIMBURSED" insert "AND DENIED".
- 25 Page 7, strike lines 25 through 27.
- 26 Page 8, strike lines 1 through 19.
- 27 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
