The Center for Employment Opportunities (CEO) is a nonprofit social enterprise dedicated to providing comprehensive workforce development services to individuals returning home from incarceration.

CEO launched its first Colorado office in Denver in 2017 and then an office in Colorado Springs in 2018.

CEO's Evidence-Based Program Model:

CEO's program model has been evaluated to increase both public safety and employment outcomes, with findings showing a 22% reduction in recidivism and 48% increase in employment after 3 years when measured to the comparison group.

RETURNING CITIZEN STIMULUS (RCS) PROGRAM

The Center for Employment Opportunities (CEO) is a nonprofit social enterprise dedicated to providing comprehensive workforce development services to individuals returning home from incarceration. In April 2020, CEO conceived and implemented the RCS program as a response to the COVID-19 pandemic and distributed over \$24M to 10,501 formerly incarcerated individuals across 28 cities. In Colorado, we partnered with the following groups to distribute cash assistance to 623 people:

Meet Employment Milestones

Over 90% of recipients completed the appropriate milestones to receive 2-3 RCS payments, 2/3s of which were employment-related milestones.



Find, Secure, & Maintain Employment

Finding employment was a high priority for most participants. RCS funds helped recipients cover transportation & clothing costs to prepare for job interviews.



All RCS recipients in the study said that the RCS funds helped them get back on their feet during this transition period.

Getting cash assistance meant a lot to me because I was laid off due to COVID. I had just moved into my own apartment, before that I was homeless living in a shelter.
