
What is a SBHC?



Clinics located in schools or on school property that offer primary, behavioral, and oral health care to children, youth and young adults.




SBHC Structure



- SBHCs are created and operated as a partnership between the school, medical sponsor, and community.
- SBHCs maintain Community
 Advisory Committees to guide activities with stakeholder input.



2021-22 Service Delivery Snapshot

- Most youth up-to-date on required immunizations.
- 50% adolescents screened for depression.
- 43% received well-child exams

Over 25% parents & patients reported that if an SBHC weren't available, they would go to a hospital or emergency room for care.

69% of youth agreed that they missed less class time




