HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Public & Behavioral Health & Human Services.

HB23-1204 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 3, strike "and (9)" and substitute "(9),  
2 (10), and (11)".

3 Page 4, before line 1 insert:

4 "(6) A RECOVERY RESIDENCE SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING IN  
5 PLACE FOR EACH CLIENT AT THE TIME AN INDIVIDUAL BECOMES A CLIENT  
6 OF THE RECOVERY RESIDENCE:

7 (a) A SIGNED PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE RECOVERY  
8 RESIDENCE AND THE CLIENT THAT OUTLINES THE REQUIREMENTS THE  
9 CLIENT MUST FOLLOW TO RESIDE AT THE RECOVERY RESIDENCE, THE DRUG  
10 SCREENING POLICY, AND THE RECOVERY RESIDENCE'S CODE OF CONDUCT  
11 WHICH PROHIBITS THE USE OF ALCOHOL, NONPRESCRIBED DRUGS, AND  
12 ILLICIT DRUGS; AND

13 (b) A RELAPSE PLAN THAT MUST BE IMPLEMENTED IF THE CLIENT  
14 RETURNS TO THE USE OF ALCOHOL, NONPRESCRIBED DRUGS, OR ILLICIT  
15 DRUGS. THE RELAPSE PLAN MUST OUTLINE STEPS THAT MUST BE TAKEN TO  
16 EVALUATE AND ADDRESS THE CLIENT'S RETURN TO USE AND TO ALLOW  
17 THE CLIENT TO REMAIN IN THE RECOVERY RESIDENCE AFTER A RELAPSE  
18 HAS OCCURRED, IF POSSIBLE."

19 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.

20 Page 4, line 7, strike "IMMEDIATELY".

21 Page 4, line 8, strike "CLIENT," and substitute "CLIENT WITHIN  
22 TWENTY-FOUR HOURS,".

23 Page 5, line 7, strike "(6)(b)" and substitute "(7)(b)".

24 Page 6, after line 12 insert:

25 "(11) A RECOVERY RESIDENCE SHALL MAKE THE RECOVERY  
26 RESIDENCE'S CODE OF CONDUCT, DRUG SCREENING POLICY, AND  
27 DISCHARGE AND TRANSFER POLICY ACCESSIBLE IN ALL COMMON AREAS OF  
28 THE RECOVERY RESIDENCE."

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
