State Measurement for Accountable, Responsive, and Transparent (SMART) Government Act Requirement: 25-20.5-1206(2)(c) C.R.S.

House Bill 21-1299 created the Office of Gun Violence Prevention in the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. According to the statute (25-20.5-1206(2)(c) C.R.S.), the department shall include a summary of the office's annual report, including instruction for accessing any new and relevant gun violence prevention research identified by the office in its annual SMART Act hearing.

On or before November 30 of each year, the office is required to report on the activities it has conducted in the preceding twelve months. The first report described early implementation activities, such as meeting with stakeholders and reviewing data tools and resources to inform the work of the office.
