Includes <u>essential</u> <u>health benefits</u> <u>and coverage</u> for preventive services at no charge.




Expert, local help

Enrollment Assistance



We offer free enrollment assistance across the state, and people are using it to get covered. We have 919 Brokers and Assisters helping people enroll this year.

Green = Enrollment Centers


Blue = Health Coverage Guides

January

We announced an <u>extra enrollment period</u> starting February 8.

March

We <u>extended the enrollment period</u> to August 15.

April

• Coloradans seeking health insurance can access more savings as a result of the American Rescue Plan. For the first time, ever, individuals and families of most income ranges can qualify for reduced premiums.

August

• A historic **216,350** Coloradans enrolled in 2021 health coverage.

Extended Enrollment Period (Feb. 8- Aug. 15)

We enrolled more people this year than in any previous year of our operation.



Implementation of Federal Policies American Rescue Plan Act of 2021



The American Rescue Plan was signed into law March 11th, 2021.

Provided additional financial help for Coloradans purchasing health coverage through Connect for Health Colorado in plan years 2021 and 2022.

Expands financial help eligibility to households with income over 400% of the federal poverty level (FPL).

Individuals can save an average of 52% on their premiums.

Families receiving Unemployment Insurance for at least one week in 2021 were eligible for \$0 net premium options.

Customers able to receive premium repayment forgiveness from the IRS for the 2020 tax year.

Connect for Health Colorado began offering ARP additional savings in April 2021

- A historic 216,350 Coloradans enrolled in health coverage when we closed the enrollment period on August 15, 2021.
- 51% of medical submissions were made with the help of a Broker or Assister.
- 999 Brokers and Assisters were certified and available to help customers make plan decisions during these special enrollment periods.
- Brokers and Assisters help customers get the financial help for which they are eligible. 83% of customers who enrolled with a Broker or Assister received Advance
 Premium Tax Credits during this time, relative to 68% for customers without enrollment assistance.
- Over 33,000 calls were answered by our Customer Service Center during the Open Enrollment period.

Health Care Coverage Easy (Tax Time) Enrollment Program

- The <u>Health Care Coverage Easy</u>
 <u>Enrollment Program</u> (HB20-1236)
 will connect uninsured Coloradans
 to free or low-cost health coverage
 using their Colorado state tax
 return.
 - Rebranding as "Tax Time Enrollment" for clarity for our customers
- Program begins January 2022.

Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise (HIAE) programs

Funding and direction from the <u>Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise</u> (Senate Bill 20-215) and its <u>Board of Directors</u> shapes **our ability to provide coverage and financial help to thousands more Coloradans.**

- Starting this Open Enrollment Period, for plan year 2022, Connect for Health Colorado is using funds to provide <u>customers with a certain income and who enroll in a silver plan with richer plan</u> <u>benefits</u>. This program made possible by HIAE will help customers afford to use their plan and access health care services.
- Thanks to the Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise, we'll be able to offer plans to people who
 are unable to obtain coverage or savings under current Affordable Care Act rules. Starting next
 Open Enrollment Period for 2023 coverage, many people who cannot afford to cover their family
 through their employer's health plan, and people who are undocumented, will be eligible for
 plans and savings on Colorado Connect, Connect for Health
 Colorado's public benefit corporation.

Open Enrollment Period Update

- 4 out of 5 Connect for Health Colorado customers can find a health insurance plan for \$25/month or less after financial help is applied.
- As of December 15, 2021, nearly 180,000 Coloradans have enrolled in a health plan- this was the deadline for Jan 1 coverage.
 - On enrollment, we're 400 short of where we finished last OE.
- It's not too late for residents to get covered. The annual Open Enrollment Period continues through January 15th for 2022 coverage.
