Department of Revenue Major Systems Overview

- DRIVES

- DMV and the counties use the DRIVES software to support all of Colorado citizens' driver license, identification, and vehicle services operations.

- GENTAX

 This is the software that supports our TAX organization's ability to receive and process returns, accept payments, issue refunds, audits, discovery and more.

- Sales & Use Tax System (SUTS)

 The SUTS System is a one-stop filing portal that enables tasks related to collecting and remitting sales tax in an easy, automated and seamless fashion through a web portal. It also offers a convenient GIS lookup to support a tax payers tax rate by location.


- METRC

DRIVES Upgrade

- Planning starting beginning FY24
- Estimated 70k hour effort
- Jumping multiple versions due to not upgrading since 2018
- Complex stakeholder community with the 64 counties actively involved
- Extensive functionality improvements

GenTax Upgrade

- Planning starting beginning FY25 or FY26
- Estimated 8 month effort
- Critical upgrade but less complex when compared to DRIVES due to simpler stakeholder community and being on v12
- Important to continue focus on customer experience enhancements







FY 2023-24 IT Capital Request




Licensing & Case Management Software Request

- This platform has been customized heavily to support our evolving and expanding needs as an agency
- This is a critical function and service for our Divisions
 - Specialized Business Group (SBG)
 - Marijuana Enforcement Division (MED)
 - Lottery Division
 - Department Motor Vehicles (DMV)
- Platform modernization effort supports our Wildly Important Goals (WIG's)
 - WIG 1 Continued expansion of Self Service Options
 - WIG 2 Increase Tools for underserved Coloradans








How does Licensing Software Benefit DOR

Licensing & Case Management Software at DOR

- The current contract expires June 30, 2024. Based on procurement best practices and business needs, a solicitation is recommended at this opportunity.
- Since we purchased MyLO there is extensive expanded scope reflective of our new business structures resulting in inefficiencies in processing, managing applications, licensing information, and case-related details.
- The current solution does not have adequate reporting or tracking capabilities.
- This impacts all Public Safety Record (PSR) users including most SBG divisions and Lottery




DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES - DRIVES WORKLOAD









DIVISION OF TAXATION - SUTS OVERVIEW





- Over \$156M remitted as of 10/31
- 56 of 68 cities are in Production





MARIJUANA ENFORCEMENT DIVISION - METRC OVERVIEW

Overview

- Provides MED the ability to identify and account for marijuana from "seed-to-sale" through a
 web-based interface coupled with radio frequency identification (RFID) technology. Required
 to be used by all licensees.
- Data is catalogued per licensee by subject matter, e.g. plants, testing and sales, which gives state regulators significant data, and allows for sophisticated data analysis.
- Analytic tools and reporting functionality for on-the-spot analysis to assist in various regulatory capacities.

Updates

- New inventory tracking functionality implemented pursuant to <u>HB21-1317</u>. Requirements include real-time tracking of patient sales.
- December 2021 MED Issued <u>Industry-Wide Bulletin</u> on required Metrc updates.
- Metrc completed a data migration to Azure, Metrc users will experience system performance improvements due to faster hardware, improved architecture, and flexibility provided by the new data center.
