

#### COLORADO JUDICIAL DISTRICTS




#### By the numbers -

- ° 22 judicial districts
- ° All 64 counties
- ° More than 100 buildings
- Approximately 4,000 court, probation staff
- 339 judges and justices

## Courts and Probation workload

- 551,929 cases filed in FY22
- Nearly 70,000 probationers supervised today





## Pandemic drives change

- Courthouse closures
- Trial delays
- Virtual proceedings become the norm

# Virtual hearings

- 670 hours of video conference per day
- 15,000 video conferences per month
- 109,000 users monthly




