

Fiber Optic Cabling Upgrade




Created redundant network connection paths for ~10 Auraria Campus buildings that were previously vulnerable to a single point of failure, including Aviation & Athletics facilities

Central Classroom Wireless Coverage




31 access points, significant coverage gaps




124 access points, comprehensive coverage

Scope

- Complete Upgrades in Remaining MSU Denver Buildings
- 2023 Kickoff

Total Investment: \$1,295,000

- \$795,000 Capital Request funds
- \$500,000 Institutional funds

 MSU Denver to apply operating funds and student fee revenue to support ongoing maintenance and future upgrades

 - Workday recommended 2-to-1 by evaluation committee
 - Unified HR, Finance and Student solution
 - 36-month implementation anticipated for 2026 go live


Colorado School of Mines

ERP/SIS Project Roadmap – MSU Denver








IT Strategic Project Roadmap - Mines
