


The ATJC works to expand access to and enhance the quality of civil justice for all Coloradans.








- ► Fear & distrust of the legal system

- ► Language & culture




- ► Technology challenges

Long-term Recommendations



- Prioritize laws that simplify procedures and protect pro se parties
- Use plain language in legislation








- > Support statewide **uniform** use of remote proceedings in appropriate cases
- Support Licensed Legal Paraprofessionals (LLPs)
- > Support electronic filing (E-filing) for *pro se* parties
