TREASURY TO SUPPORT THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE PROPERTY
TAX DEFERRAL PROGRAM DURING THE 2023-24 STATE FISCAL
YEAR.

Bill Summary

For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, the bill appropriates \$87,910 to the department of the treasury to support the administration of property tax deferrals for the 2023 property tax year as part of the property tax

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** Appropriation. For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, 3 \$87,910 is appropriated to the department of the treasury. This 4 appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that 5 the department will require an additional 1.0 FTE. The department may use this appropriation to support the administration of the property tax 6 7 deferral program. 8 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, 9 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 10 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for 11 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state 12 institutions.
