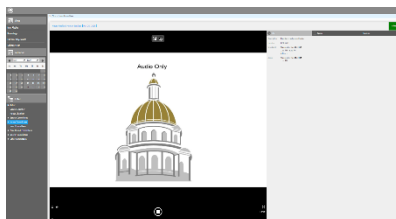

**SUBJECT:** Enabling Streaming Video of Committees Through Sliq Media Technologies

The Legislative Department currently contracts with [Sliq Media Technologies](https://www.sliq.com/)<sup>1</sup> to provide audio streaming of legislative chambers and committees on the legislature's website. The company offers an add-on service that would stream video using the same technology.

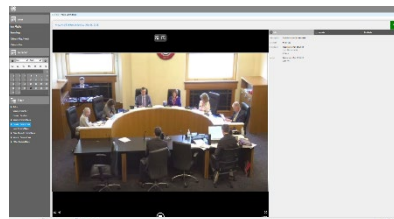
Enabling video streaming through Sliq would not change the user experience, except that the window that currently displays a Capitol Building icon on the audio streaming web page (see Figure 1) will instead contain streaming video. Cameras currently installed in each room would accommodate a static view of the main dais in each room (see Figure 2). If desired by chamber leadership, a second camera could focus on the witness table. The technology allows for flexibility to display either camera individually or both simultaneously (see Figure 3).

Should you choose to enable video streaming, staff recommends that the Executive Committee set operational policies prior to its implementation, and recommends implementation in FY 2025-26. Adding streaming video to 14 rooms would require \$70,000 in the first year, which would include a \$20,000 one-time setup fee and a \$50,000 annual fee.

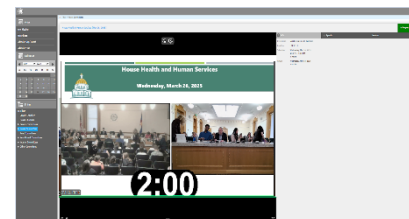
**Figure 1**
