UPK Rule Updates for Additional Care

In order for a child to receive additional hours of care from UPK, that child must be between three- and four-years old (year before Kindergarten), as well as meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Child lives in a low-income household (270% of the 2023 Federal Poverty Guidelines).
- Child is a dual language learner and the native language spoken in the child's home is a language other than English, or the child's native language is not English.
- Child has an Individualized Education Program (IEP)
- Child is currently in a foster care home or in non-certified kinship care.
- Child is identified as homeless.

**For children younger than three-years-old in a district with a waiver to serve children younger than three, the specific number of hours for these children will be determined in November alongside the provider rate.




UPK Technology - Milestones Updates






UPK Technology - Data Integration
