Current Subcommittee updates:

Crisis System—want to focus on alternative response and expand stakeholder pool or participants.

Recidivism—on hold. Follow bills and wait for direction.

Competency—on hold. Waiting for direction. Dust off the behavioral health task force recommendations around SIM and areas for focus in the realm of competency.

Juvenile—took a break and met again last week. Try to meet every other week. Discussed some of the unofficial topics from LOC and desire for clarification. Did an internal poll to identify what is really important: treatment availability, YOS, JAC model, and juvenile NGRI. Continue to be concerned about membership of the subcommittee. Trying to expand representation in the group.

New Subcommittees:

1. Transition recidivism subcommittee to the system as a whole. Systems of Care
2. NGRI—started with postpartum psychosis and depression, but the issue is much broader. Need to review and update these laws. Does the current structure match our modern views around criminal responsibility? Role of substance use. Legal questions to consider. Look at some of the procedural sides.
3. Juvenile—where might NGRI issues with youth fit in. Add some previous members who were involved in this area (follow up with Gina)
