Bill Summary

Transportation Legislation Review Committee. The bill changes the classification of certain offenses involving the operation of a commercial motor vehicle from a class A traffic infraction to a class 1 misdemeanor traffic offense. This penalty, however, does not apply if the defendant presents a valid commercial driver's license to the court within 30 days after the citation or at the person's first scheduled court

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-404, amend (3)
3	as follows:
4	42-2-404. Commercial driver's license - limitations - rules.
5	(3) In addition to any applicable federal penalty concerning commercial
6	motor vehicle operators, any person who violates subsection (1) or (2) of
7	this section, or any rule or regulation promulgated by the department
8	pursuant to this part 4, commits a class A traffic infraction 1
9	MISDEMEANOR TRAFFIC OFFENSE; EXCEPT THAT THE PENALTIES SPECIFIED
10	In section 42-4-1701 (3)(a)(II)(A) do not apply if the Person who
11	VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION PRESENTS A VALID
12	COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE TO THE APPLICABLE COURT WITHIN
13	THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE CITATION OR AT THE PERSON'S FIRST
14	SCHEDULED COURT APPEARANCE.
15	SECTION 2. Applicability. This act applies to offenses
16	committed on or after the effective date of this act.
17	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
18	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
19	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
