Wildfire Matters Review Committee. The bill directs the director of the division of fire prevention and control (division) within the department of public safety to report on the investigation of wildland fires in the state and creates the fire investigation fund to fund fire investigations. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1203.5, 3 amend (3) as follows: 4 Powers and duties of director - report. 24-33.5-1203.5. 5 (3) Commencing in 2014, the director shall report annually to the 6 wildfire matters review committee created in section 2-3-1602 C.R.S., 7 regarding the current nature and magnitude of the state's wildfire 8 situation; THE NUMBER OF WILDLAND FIRE INVESTIGATIONS THE DIVISION 9 CONDUCTED IN THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR AND THE STATUS OF 10 EACH INVESTIGATION; the status of wildfire preparedness and prescribed 11 burns in the state, including available resources; and the challenges to 12 addressing the state's wildfire threat. The report required by this 13 subsection (3) is exempt from the automatic expiration described in 14 section 24-1-136 (11). 15 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-33.5-1236 as 16 follows: 17 **24-33.5-1236.** Fire investigation fund - created - rules. (1) THE 18 FIRE INVESTIGATION FUND, REFERRED TO IN THIS SECTION AS THE "FUND", 19 IS HEREBY CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY. THE FUND CONSISTS OF ANY 20 MONEY THAT MAY BE APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND BY THE GENERAL 21 ASSEMBLY, ALL PRIVATE AND PUBLIC MONEY RECEIVED THROUGH GIFTS, 22 GRANTS, OR DONATIONS THAT ARE TRANSMITTED TO THE STATE 23 TREASURER AND CREDITED TO THE FUND, AND MONEY TRANSFERRED TO 24 THE FUND PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (4) OF THIS SECTION. THE STATE 25 TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL INTEREST AND INCOME DERIVED FROM THE

16	(b) THE DIVISION SHALL PRIORITIZE THE USE OF MONEY FROM THE
17	FUND FOR WILDLAND FIRE INVESTIGATIONS AND MAY USE MONEY FROM
18	THE FUND FOR THE INVESTIGATION OF OTHER FIRES, SUBJECT TO THE
