

Generation: We have more than 617 megawatts of owned wind, solar and natural gas power generation capacity in Colorado to meet our customers' growing energy needs.





· Use a water heater wrap. Water heaters account for about 20% of home energy usage. You can save energy by installing an insulation kit to have a cozy water heater that's more energy efficient. Even better, consider replacing your old water heater with a high efficiency model.

· Efficiency in the kitchen. Cooking uses a lot of energy, but there are ways to reduce usage. Keep your oven door closed and use the oven window instead. Use the right size pans for the burners and shut the heat off a few minutes before your goodies are done to let the remaining heat finish the job.
