




#### DHE Organizational Chart





#### Colorado's Institutions of Higher Education




# FAFSA Completion

#### Wildly Important Goal:

Increase FAFSA completion among high school seniors in Colorado from 42% to 55% by June 30, 2023.





#### Wildly Important Goals:

Decrease the overall percentage of students graduating with debt from 48% to 45% by June 30, 2023.

Decrease the average amount of debt per graduating student from \$22,673 to below \$20,000 by June 30, 2023.




#### FY 2023-24 Budget Snapshot


