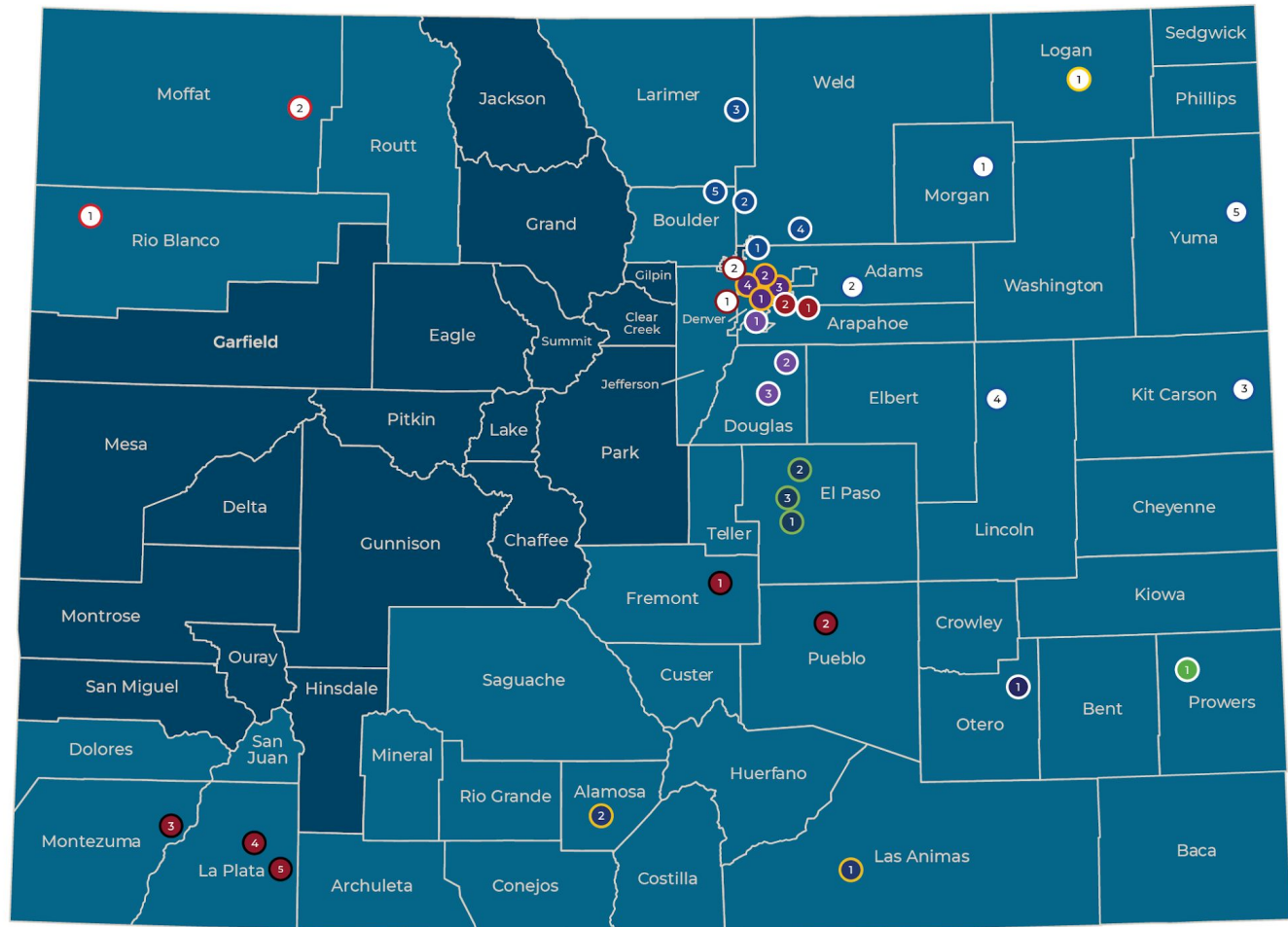

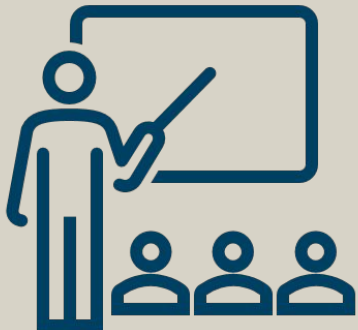
Historic Funding
