

Background & Overview

Launched in September 2020, the Illuminating Child Care Program began as a pilot project in the Denver metro area to address a critical need for child care services among parents and caregivers accessing behavioral health and family support services in Colorado.

Through the Illuminating Child Care program, Recreational Vehicles (RVs) are retrofitted into infant and toddler classrooms to provide safe, drop-in child care services on-site at behavioral health and family support facilities. Early Childhood Teachers engage young children in age-appropriate activities that promote social emotional development, providing a nurturing environment for children while their caregivers are accessing the services they need.





Over the past 2+ years, the Illuminating Child Care program has expanded to two additional regions in Colorado (San Luis Valley and Southeast Colorado regions). The program operates three child care classrooms (Acorn, Honey, and Caramel) that provide child care services to 15 behavioral health and family support facilities across the state.









Program Reach - Caregivers


