## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING DIRECT-TO-CONSUMER SALES OF RAW MILK.

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Water Resources and Agriculture Review Committee. The bill authorizes a raw milk producer (producer) that registers with the department of public health and environment (department) to engage in direct-to-consumer sales of raw milk in the state if the producer complies with certain labeling, storage, handling, record-keeping, and transportation requirements. The direct-to-consumer sales may take place at the producer's place of business, at the consumer's residence, or at a farmers' market or roadside market. The bill authorizes the department to:

- Adopt rules related to record keeping and the storage, handling, labeling, and transportation of raw milk intended for sale directly to consumers;
- Inspect and embargo producers' raw milk and operations;
- Enforce against a violation in court or by imposition of a civil penalty and, if 2 or more separate violations are committed in a 12-month period, suspend the producer from selling raw milk for 12 months; and
- Prepare and distribute educational materials.

- 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-5.5-101, add
- 3 (16.3), (16.5), and (16.7) as follows:
- 4 **25-5.5-101. Definitions.** (16.3) (a) "RAW MILK" MEANS
- 5 UNPASTEURIZED COW OR GOAT MILK.
- 6 (b) "RAWMILK" DOES NOT INCLUDE UNPASTEURIZED HUMAN MILK.
- 7 (16.5) "RAW MILK PRODUCER" MEANS A FARMER, FARM, OR DAIRY
- 8 THAT PRODUCES RAW MILK.
- 9 (16.7) "RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT":
- 10 (a) Except as provided in subsection (16.7)(b) of this
- 11 SECTION, HAS THE MEANING SET FORTH IN SECTION 25-4-1602 (14); AND
- 12 (b) Does not include a farmers' market or a roadside
- 13 MARKET.
- SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-5.5-117, amend
- 15 (3); and **add** (6), (7), (8), (9), (10), (11), and (12) as follows:
- 16 25-5.5-117. Raw milk direct-to-consumer sales -
- 17 requirements restrictions enforcement rules. (3) Retail sales of
- raw, unpasteurized milk shall not be allowed ARE PROHIBITED, EXCEPT AS
- 19 AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION FOR DIRECT-TO-CONSUMER SALES, Resale
- of raw milk obtained from a cow share or goat share is strictly prohibited.
- 21 Raw milk that is not intended for pasteurization shall not be sold to or

5	(6) (a) On and after January 1, 2025, and notwithstanding
6	SUBSECTION (6)(b) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON IN THE STATE SHALL NOT
7	SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE RAW MILK AT OR THROUGH:
8	(I) A RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT, INCLUDING A FOOD CO-OP;
9	(II) USE OF A FOOD DELIVERY SERVICE; OR
10	(III) COMMUNITY-SUPPORTED AGRICULTURE.
11	(b) On and after January 1, 2025, a raw milk producer that
12	HAS REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2)
13	OF THIS SECTION MAY SELL OR OFFER TO SELL RAW MILK DIRECTLY TO A
14	CONSUMER IF:
15	(I) THE SALE OR OFFER TO SELL TAKES PLACE AT THE LOCATION
16	WHERE THE RAW MILK IS PRODUCED, THE CONSUMER'S RESIDENCE, OR A
17	FARMERS' MARKET OR ROADSIDE MARKET;
18	(II) RAW MILK OFFERED FOR SALE IS PLACED IN A STERILE OR
19	SINGLE-USE CONTAINER AND SOLD NO MORE THAN FIVE DAYS AFTER THE
20	CONTAINER IS FILLED;
21	(III) WHEN TRANSPORTING THE RAW MILK FOR SALE OR DELIVERY:
22	(A) THE RAW MILK PRODUCER OR ANY PERSON WHO TRANSPORTS
23	OR DELIVERS RAW MILK ON BEHALF OF A RAW MILK PRODUCER PURSUANT
24	TO SUBSECTION (8) OF THIS SECTION MAINTAINS THE RAW MILK IN AIR
25	TEMPERATURES AT OR BELOW FORTY DEGREES FAHRENHEIT AT ALL TIMES
26	EXCEPT DURING THE TRANSFER OF THE RAW MILK FROM ONE STORAGE
27	AREA TO ANOTHER OR FROM ONE TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE TO ANOTHER:

2	(B) THE RAW MILK PRODUCER OR ANY PERSON WHO TRANSPORTS
3	OR DELIVERS RAW MILK ON BEHALF OF A RAW MILK PRODUCER PURSUANT
4	TO SUBSECTION (8) OF THIS SECTION PROTECTS THE RAW MILK FROM
5	EXPOSURE TO DIRECT SUNLIGHT;
6	(IV) THE RAW MILK PRODUCER MAINTAINS THE RAW MILK IN
7	ACCORDANCE WITH ANY ADDITIONAL STORAGE, HANDLING, LABELING,
8	RECORD-KEEPING, AND TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS THAT THE
9	EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT ESTABLISHES BY RULE
10	PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (7) OF THIS SECTION;
11	(V) THE RAW MILK PRODUCER AFFIXES A LABEL TO EACH
12	CONTAINER OF RAW MILK SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE. THE LABEL MUST:
13	(A) CONTAIN LANGUAGE THAT THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE
14	DEPARTMENT ADOPTS BY RULE ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2024, WHICH
15	MUST WARN THAT THE RAW MILK IS UNPASTEURIZED AND THAT ITS
16	CONSUMPTION INCREASES THE RISK OF ILLNESS, ESPECIALLY FOR
17	HIGH-RISK INDIVIDUALS, INCLUDING INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE PREGNANT OR
18	NURSING, CHILDREN, AND THE ELDERLY; AND
19	(B) BE PROMINENTLY PLACED ON THE CONTAINER.
20	(VI) THE RAW MILK PRODUCER SUBMITS A SAMPLE OF THE LABEL
21	THAT THE RAW MILK PRODUCER WILL AFFIX TO EACH CONTAINER OF RAW
22	MILK SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE
23	DEPARTMENT APPROVES THE SAMPLE LABEL.
24	(7) On or before December 31, 2024, the executive director

OF THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT RULES SETTING FORTH ADDITIONAL SAFE STORAGE, HANDLING, LABELING, RECORD-KEEPING, AND TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS FOR RAW MILK THAT IS SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE

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1	PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.
2	(8) A RAW MILK PRODUCER MAY CONTRACT WITH ANOTHER
3	PERSON TO TRANSPORT OR DELIVER RAW MILK IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS
4	SECTION. THE RAW MILK PRODUCER AND SUCH OTHER PERSON ARE
5	JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY LIABLE FOR ANY VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION OR
6	OF ANY RULE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, WHICH VIOLATION IS
7	COMMITTED BY THE OTHER PERSON.
8	(9) This section does not authorize:
9	(a) THE SALE OF RAW MILK TO OR ON THE PREMISES OF A RETAIL
10	FOOD ESTABLISHMENT;
11	(b) THE SALE OR OFFER FOR SALE OF RAW MILK BY ANY PERSON
12	OTHER THAN A RAW MILK PRODUCER REGISTERED PURSUANT TO
13	SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION;
14	(c) THE SALE OR OFFER FOR SALE OF RAW MILK FOR OTHER THAN
15	HUMAN CONSUMPTION UNLESS IT HAS BEEN TREATED WITH A DYE
16	APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 25-1-114
17	(1)(i);
18	(d) THE RESALE OF RAW MILK BY A CONSUMER; OR
19	(e) The sale of any products made from raw milk,
20	INCLUDING YOGURT, KEFIR, AND BUTTER.
21	(10) Pursuant to the department's authority under
22	SECTION 25-1.5-102 (1)(a)(I) TO INVESTIGATE AND CONTROL THE CAUSES
23	OF EPIDEMIC AND COMMUNICABLE DISEASES AFFECTING THE PUBLIC
24	HEALTH, THE DEPARTMENT, UPON RECEIPT OF A COMPLAINT BY A THIRD
25	PARTY OR ON ITS OWN MOTION, MAY:
26	(a) TEST A RAW MILK PRODUCER'S RAW MILK;

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(b) INSPECT A RAW MILK PRODUCER'S RAW MILK STORAGE,

1	HANDLING, OR TRANSPORTATION OPERATIONS AND REVIEW LABELING
2	AFFIXED TO RAW MILK CONTAINERS;
3	(c) REQUEST RECORDS FROM A RAW MILK PRODUCER REGARDING
4	THE RAW MILK PRODUCER'S RAW MILK PRODUCTION OPERATION, SALES, OR
5	DISTRIBUTION; OR
6	(d) Embargo a raw milk producer's raw milk and prohibit
7	ITS SALE DURING THE DEPARTMENT'S INVESTIGATION.
8	(11) If the department determines that a person has
9	VIOLATED THIS SECTION OR ANY RULE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS
10	SECTION, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT MAY:
11	(a) Request that the attorney general's office or the
12	DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT IN WHICH THE ALLEGED
13	VIOLATION OCCURRED, ON THE DEPARTMENT'S BEHALF, BRING AN ACTION
14	IN A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION; OR
15	(b) Upon notice and an opportunity to be heard, impose a
16	CIVIL PENALTY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS
17	PER VIOLATION. EACH CONTAINER OF RAW MILK SOLD IN VIOLATION OF
18	THIS SECTION CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE VIOLATION. IF THE DEPARTMENT
19	DETERMINES THAT A RAW MILK PRODUCER HAS COMMITTED TWO OR MORE
20	SEPARATE VIOLATIONS WITHIN A TWELVE MONTH PERIOD, THE
21	DEPARTMENT MAY SUSPEND FOR A PERIOD OF TWELVE MONTHS THE RAW
22	${\tt MILKPRODUCER'SREGISTRATIONISSUEDPURSUANTTOSUBSECTION(2)OF}$
23	THIS SECTION. THE RAW MILK PRODUCER MAY RENEW THE RAW MILK
24	PRODUCER'S REGISTRATION TO ENGAGE IN DIRECT-TO-CONSUMER SALES
25	OF RAW MILK AFTER THE TWELVE-MONTH SUSPENSION PERIOD HAS
26	ELAPSED.
27	(12) The department may prepare and distribute

1	EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS REGARDING THE CONSUMPTION OF RAW MILK,
2	WHICH MATERIALS MAY INCLUDE LANGUAGE STATING THAT THERE ARE
3	NOT PROVEN HEALTH BENEFITS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSUMPTION OF
4	RAW MILK, BUT THERE ARE KNOWN HARMS ASSOCIATED WITH ITS
5	CONSUMPTION, SUCH AS SEVERE INFECTIONS.
6	SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
7	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
8	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
9	that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
10	of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
11	act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
12	effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
13	November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
14	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
