

On October 29, 2024, the Capital Development Committee (CDC) considered one property transaction proposal from the Colorado Division of Parks and Wildlife (CPW). The proposal was presented pursuant to Section 33-1-105 (3)(a), C.R.S., which requires the CDC to review and comment on CPW real property transactions. The CDC favorably recommends the proposal to the Parks and Wildlife Commission. Table 1 summarizes the approved proposal and a description of the approved proposal is attached. The proposal passed unanimously.

### **Summary of Proposal:**

Colorado Parks and Wildlife has the opportunity to lease the grazing rights associated with 1,280 acres of land from KMLS Properties, LLC. The landowner will be compensated for not grazing the property. Not grazing the land will maximize the amount and quality of available nest habitat for lesser-prairie chickens. In recent years, the property has never been subject to cultivated agricultural practices involving plowing or tilling of the soil.

The Property has a vital role in grassland habitat conservation for the Lesser Prairie Chicken as well as other wildlife.
