Equal rights and opportunities

Digital Accessibility

Equal access to information

Nothing is ever 100% accessible.

It is possible to comply with technical standards and provide accommodation.



"Accessible"

Conforms to accessibility related technical standards.

One in four Coloradans





House Bill 21-1110

- All public and internal digital content must be accessible.
- Applies to all Colorado government entities
- Each entity is responsible for their own content.
- Punitive consequences
- July 1, 2024 deadline



Senate Bill 23-244

- Granted rulemaking authority to the Governor's Office of Information Technology (OIT)
- Allows for reasonable accommodations
- Clarifies punitive consequences:
 - If multiple violations occur in single digital product, this is considered a single incident.

Third-party Products

- Software
 - Microsoft Word, Zoom, etc.
- Websites
 - The Colorado Channel



Third-party Compliance

- Accessibility Conformance Report (ACR)
- Voluntary Product Accessibility Template (VPAT)

Failed VPAT








Plan of Action 2023 Timeline






