Summary of Legislation

Current law requires the Department of Transportation (CDOT) to follow certain bidding procedures for projects expected to cost more than \$250,000. This bill raises that threshold to \$350,000 and indexes the threshold to inflation for future years.

State Expenditures

More of CDOT's public projects, such as maintenance projects, will be exempt from bidding requirements, decreasing bid-related workload for those projects. Overall, the bill has no impact on the funding available for public projects.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
