HFA focuses on building nurturing, safe and secure relationships between parent and child that are essential for all children -and parents- to lead a healthy and productive life. Voluntary home visiting helps new and expectant parents develop the skills and confidence to raise healthy children and increases family well-being by preventing adversity and building resilience during a child's most critical years of development.



97% of families live in low-income households


77% of families have a caregiver who is age 21 or younger
