This budget request was a net-zero FY 2022-23 Budget Amendment that shifted \$4,725,002 from CDHS and HCPF Common Policy budgets to the Colorado Benefits Management System (CBMS). This ensured CBMS paid for OIT administrative/overhead costs. It also benefited the state budget by reducing the net General Fund impact of OIT's Administration. This request did not require a project as this was a technical financial change. As such, all work to fulfill the requests intent has been completed.
