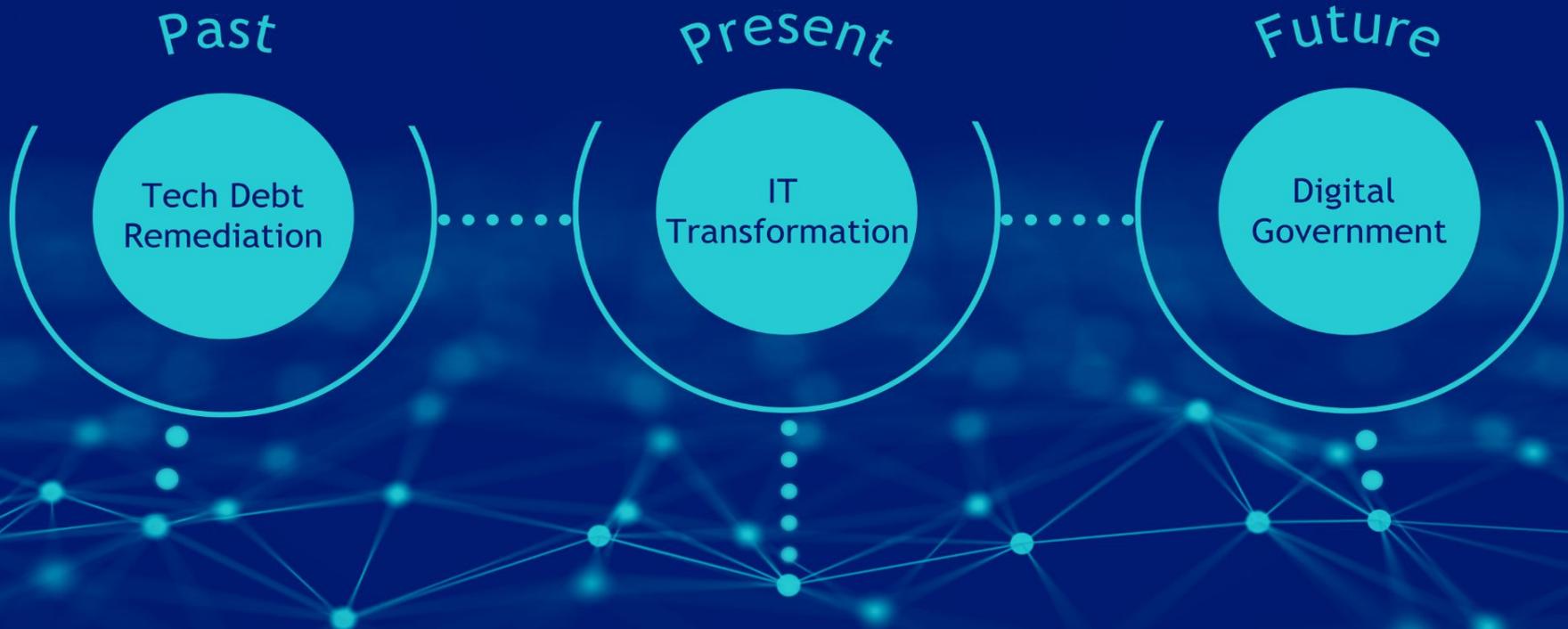

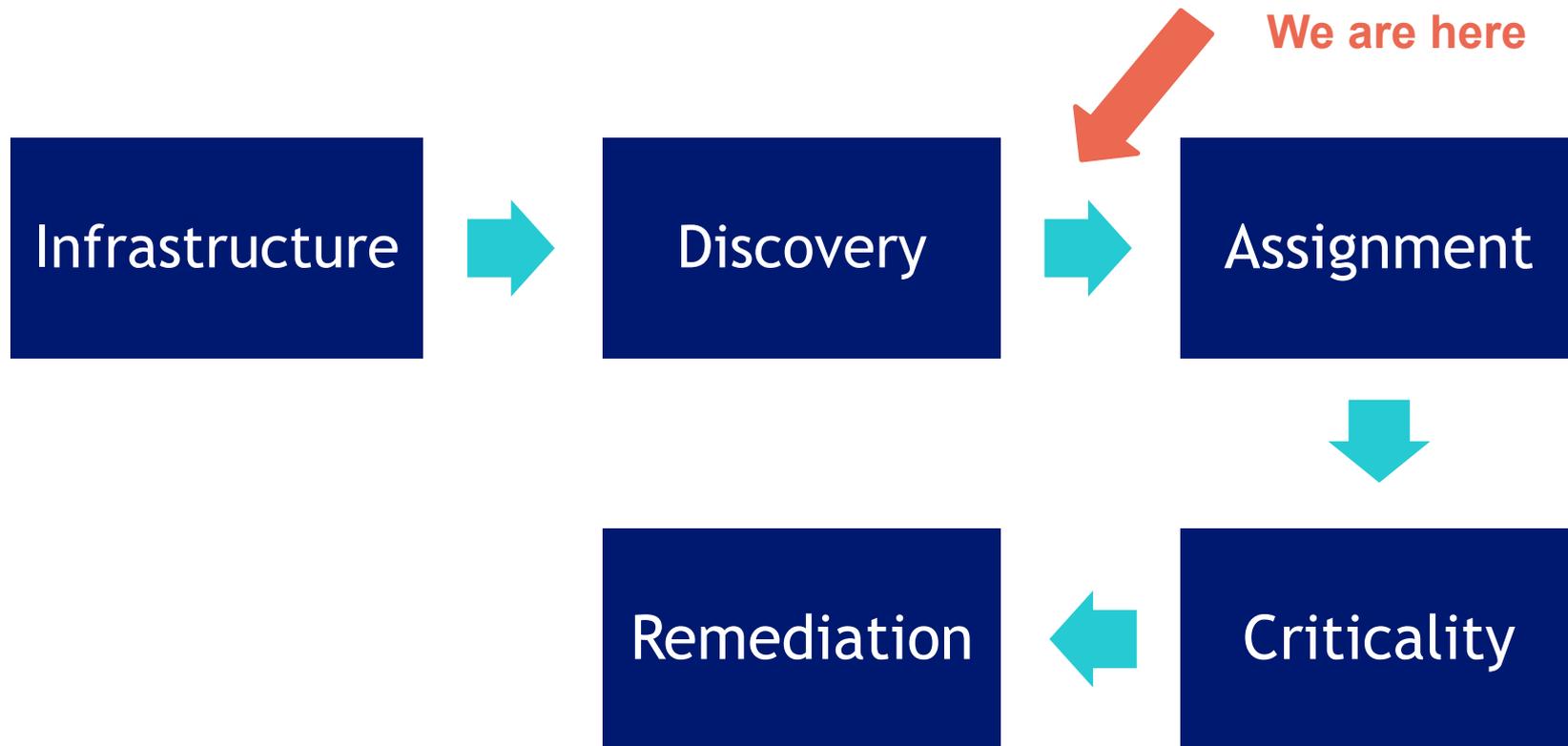

The 12 findings areas include 72 specific items

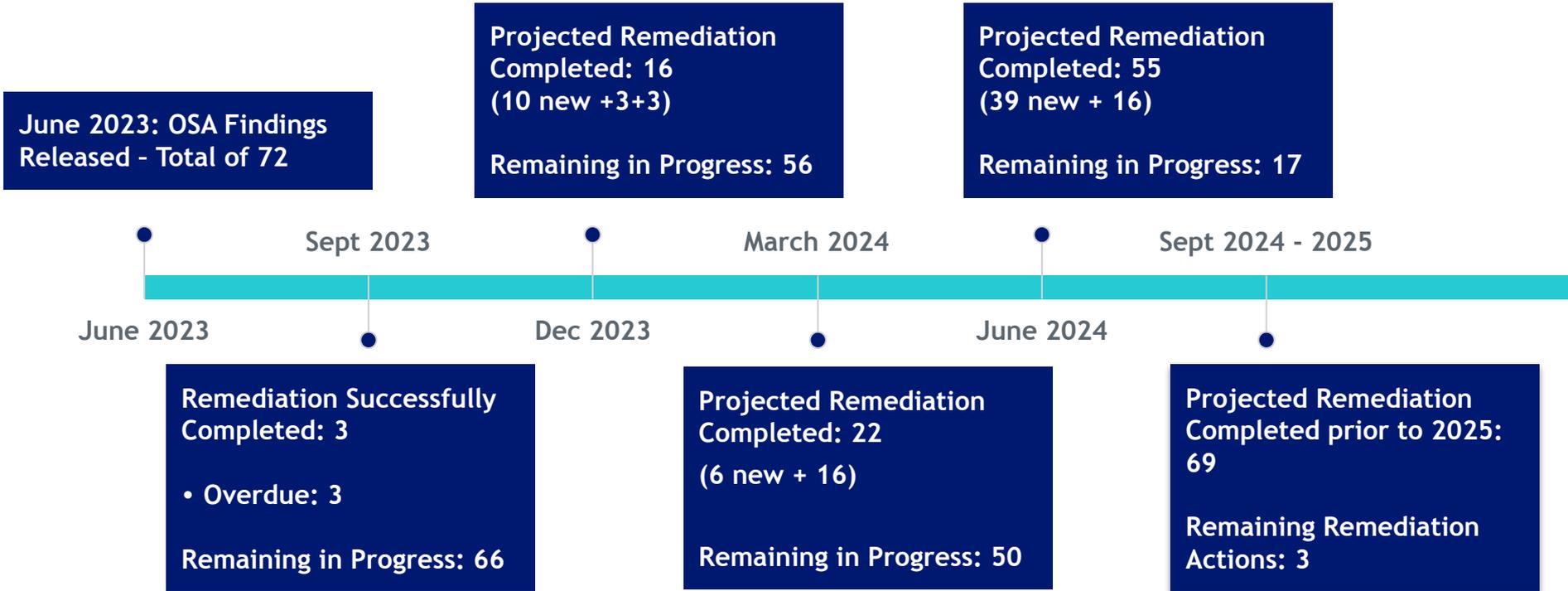


Audit Workflow

R-01 Modernizing Aging IT Systems

Tech Debt Portfolio Updates: Overall Portfolio - 49% complete

- Mainframe Decommission Project - **85% Complete**
 - The state-owned mainframe migration to the new vendor-hosted environment occurred on July 29
 - **Estimated completion date - Q3 2023**
- 6 modernization projects are in progress and running parallel to the mainframe migration
 - Child support enforcement (ACSES), State ID numbers (SIDMOD) & Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) applications projects are underway as of May 2023
 - The State Verification Exchange Application (SVES) demand was added to the portfolio in Q2 2023
 - The TIBCO Cyberfusion application is being replaced with the TIBCO Managed File Transfer application in order to remain compliant with the Social Security Administration and Internal Revenue Service
 - **This project is 84% complete as of August 15, 2023**
- IT Asset Management and Salesforce Vulnerability Remediation Projects
 - Salesforce Remediation project is **78% complete**



R-01 Modernizing Aging IT Systems

- **Exit eFORT Project - 52% Complete**
 - **eFORT migrations - 54% complete**
 - Jan. 2022 - 178 occupied racks in the leased eFORT Data Center
 - FY 22-23 project tracking began with 145 occupied racks
 - July 31, 2023 - 65 of the 145 racks have been emptied (or 45%) and 95 of the original 178 (or 53%)
 - Software and hardware are being moved to the Cloud or the state-owned Data Center
 - On target to be out of the leased eFORT Data Center by January 2025
 - **Cloud Migration Program - 50% Complete**
 - Core Network Refresh Project
 - CORE Network Refresh project team is updating the existing network equipment, firewalls and wireless controllers to ensure network infrastructure is up-to-date and secure
 - WINDOWS 2008 / WINDOWS 2012 Project
 - OIT successfully decommissioned or migrated 109 of the 171 total Windows 2008 servers.
 - The Windows 2012 project is completing server inventory. Once complete, they will begin evaluating servers for decommissioning or upgrades

eFORT Migration as of July 31, 2023

* Each stack shown represents five racks. As racks are migrated out of the eFORT data center, they will become dark blue (empty) racks.





Update on FY 2023-24 Tech Debt Project

FY 2023-24 R-01 Secure Colorado: Meet the Current & Future Threats

- This request included funding (\$2,000,000) to transition the state's email domain from .co.us to .gov
- We are pausing and rescoping the .gov transition project and will be re-prioritizing these funds toward the most pressing security related audit findings
- OIT will continue to provide regular updates on both projects going forward

Colorado Broadband Office Updates

- **Capital Projects Fund (CPF) \$162M**
 - Application window open until Sept. 22
 - 60+ applications in process
 - November 2023 awards announced
- **Broadband, Equity, Access and Deployment Program (BEAD) \$826.5M**
 - 5-Year Action Plan published Aug. 14
 - Initial Proposal Content and Timeline:
 - Inventory of unserved and underserved locations
 - Community anchor institution classification and identification
 - Modifications to the National Broadband Map
 - Timeline for Volume 1 is Sept. through Oct.
 - Timeline for Volume 2 is Oct. through Nov.
 - Timeline for the challenge process starts Jan. 2024



Colorado Broadband Office Updates

- **Broadband Deployment Fund**

- Summer cycle had 12 applicants requesting \$13.6M in funding
- The BDB has \$7.2M available of which \$2.1M is allocated to critically unserved and \$5M allocated to underserved
- Aug. - Sept. is public comment and applicant presentations

- **Other Programs**

- **Digital Equity Survey (OFOW):** Informs the state of affordability and digital skills needs across the state (open until Sept. 15)
- **Workforce Development:** Public comment period is complete, CBO received 40+ comments. Next steps: Finalize the plan and publish document in a few weeks
- **Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP):** More than 214,053 households enrolled with a 26% participation rate representing \$6.5M in investments
- **Summer Roadshow:** CBO staff visited 15+ regions across the state
