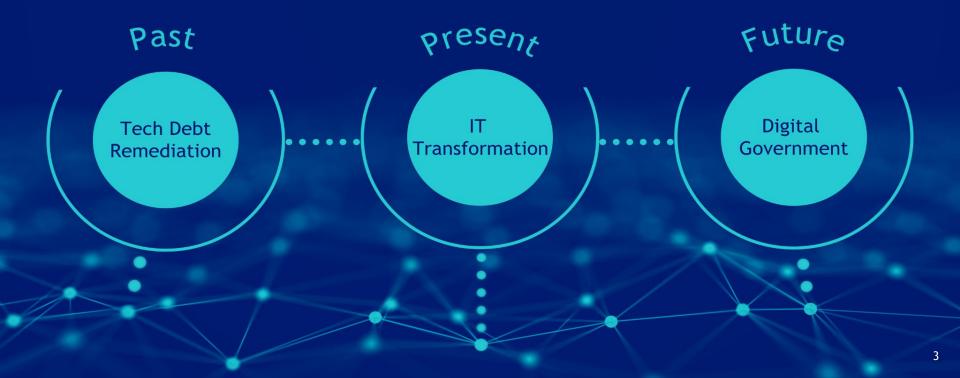

## R-01 Modernizing Aging IT Systems (Tech Debt)

#### Tech Debt Portfolio Updates: Overall Portfolio - 35% complete

- Exit eFORT Project- 45% Complete
  - The eFORT migrations are underway
    - Jan. 2022 Project started with 145 occupied "racks" in the leased eFORT Data Center
    - As of April 2023, 55 of the racks had been "emptied" and project was 45% complete
      - Software and hardware are being moved out of the data center applications and services are being moved to the cloud or to the state-owned Lakewood Data Center
    - On target to be out of the leased eFORT Data Center by 1st quarter 2024
  - Cloud Migration Program- 50% Complete
    - Core Network Refresh Project
      - CORE Network Refresh project team is updating the existing network equipment, firewalls and wireless controllers to ensure network infrastructure is up-to-date and secure.
    - WINDOWS 2008 / WINDOWS 2012 Project
      - Windows 2008 has 171 total servers and OIT successfully decommissioned or migrated 101.
      - The Windows 2012 project is completing server inventory (collecting server information). Once complete, they will begin evaluating servers for decommissioning or upgrades.

## R-01 Modernizing Aging IT Systems (Tech Debt)

#### **Tech Debt Portfolio Updates**

- Mainframe Decommission Project 45% Complete
  - The mainframe migration to the hosted environment will occur on July 29. During the cutover, mainframe production moves from the State of Colorado to our new cloud service vendor, Ensono.
  - Estimated completion date of 3rd quarter 2023
- There are 5 modernization projects in progress and running parallel to the mainframe migration
  - ACSES, SIDMOD and EBT modernization (Child support enforcement, State ID numbers & Electronic Benefit Transfer applications) efforts are underway.
    - They were approved as projects in May 2023
  - Colorado Personnel & Payroll System (CPPS) modernization effort is outside the scope of the Tech Debt Portfolio and will be managed by DPA.
  - The TIBCO Cyberfusion application is being replaced with the TIBCO Managed File Transfer Application in order to remain compliant with the Social Security Administration.
    - This project is 69% complete as of June 2023
- IT Asset Management and Salesforce Vulnerability Remediation Projects
  - IT Asset Management effort is complete within the scope of the Tech Debt Portfolio

• Salesforce Remediation effort is **69% complete**

## **BA-01 IT Accessibility**

#### Budget Status

- Continued funding from HB21-1110: SiteImprove website monitoring tool, 1 FTE
- Continued TAP funding FY 2022-23: \$1.8M used to hire the 5 FTE + funding for training,
   software and services
- Incoming Accessibility Budget/SB23-244: \$45M distributed to most State Executive Branch agencies to do accessibility work including testing and remediation of digital products
- SIPA Innovation Grant: 90K to develop empathy lab to inform agencies on accessibility experiences and challenges to better address digital accessibility needs



## **BA-01 IT Accessibility**

### • Testing and Remediation

- Providing TAP funded accessibility testing and remediation software to state agencies
- Partnering with SIPA for bug reporting/remediation of Colorado.gov platform issues
- Support agencies using Siteimprove platform to monitor websites and make improvements
- Scoping and identifying additional websites and accessibility scores
  - Identified 1,000+ state agency applications
  - 477 state websites and growing (up from 355 last year at this time)
  - Scores range from 56.9 (GA's website) to 100 (CDPS, COBEOC, MARS, & CDE's Online Libraries)
  - June 2023 Siteimprove data showed us:
  - 30% of our sites are above the 90/100 threshold now; 89% of our sites are over the prior threshold of 80/100; 11% of our sites are below the prior threshold of 80/100



## **BA-01 IT Accessibility**

#### Training and Information Sharing

- State agencies averaging 30% completion of accessibility plans with some agencies up to 67%
- Webinars, presentations, events, and Newsletter with 1300+ subscribers
- Development and integration of accessibility-related processes, tools and training
- Developed and distributed accessibility training courses, presentations, guides, & other resources

#### Other Wins

- Successful launch of Aira visual interpreter service for blind and low vision individuals
- Integrated accessibility into IT vendor procurement process

### **BA02-CBMS OIT Admin. Allocation**

- This request was a net-zero FY 2022-23 Budget Amendment that shifted \$4,725,002 from HCPF and CDHS Common Policy budgets to the Colorado Benefits Management System (CBMS)
  - This change ensured CBMS pays the correct amount for OIT administrative/overhead costs
  - This request benefited the state budget by reducing the net General Fund impact of OIT's Administration
  - This request was not a project, it was a technical financial change that aligned with
     OIT's move to real time billing and IT transformation efforts



### Colorado Broadband Office Updates

### Capital Projects Fund \$162M

- Grant Guidelines public feedback process complete
- Application opens on June 20
- 60-day application window
- Anticipated awards by the end of 2023

#### Broadband, Equity, Access and Deployment Program (BEAD)

- June 30 notification of BEAD allocation from the NTIA
- 5-Year Action Plan final draft under review due August 28
- Initial proposal process begins in July



### Colorado Broadband Office Updates

#### Broadband Deployment Fund

- Winter 2023 cycle complete \$8.1M in High Cost Support Mechanism awarded and \$3.4M in State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds awarded
- Summer grant cycle kickoff is May 15th

#### Other Programs

- Digital Equity
- Workforce Development
- Affordable Connectivity Program
- Summer Roadshow across Colorado
