**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING REGULATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH OF THE DISPOSAL OF NATURALLY OCCURRING RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** 25-11-104 (1) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1989 Repl. Vol., as amended, is amended to read:

**25-11-104. Rules and regulations to be adopted - fees - fund created.**

(1) (b) The state board of health ~~shall~~ MAY adopt regulations concerning THE DISPOSAL OF naturally occurring radioactive materials ~~prior to January 1, 1994~~ AT ANY TIME AFTER THE PROMULGATION BY THE FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY OR ITS SUCCESSOR OF RULES FOR THE DISPOSAL OF NATURALLY OCCURRING RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS.

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
